Establish a working foundation for future grant success by mapping key grant sources, developing internal tracking tools, and initiating a shared grant planning calendar for FY27.

Successfully complete Phase 4 of the 8-phase AED expansion plan by installing new AED units in at least 90% of identified gap areas, based on the most recent campus-wide coverage assessment.
